<u>1. Title of the Practice:</u>

GREEN CAMPUS INITIATIVES 2020-21

2. Objective of the Practice:

- The Green Campus, Clean Campus practice began with an objective of accepting ecofriendly practices and making the campus environmentally maintainable.
- We aim to build a campus that is plastic free, produces negligible waste and preserves energy, practices self-sustainability in areas of power, water and hygiene.
- This is a collective effort of our students and staff in an effort to identify our responsibility for the society and the country.

3. The Context:

The College is spread in an area of 36 acres with two buildings, lush sprawling grounds, full of plants, trees with medicinal and herbal properties. The variety of grasses, herbs, shrubs and trees also help in recharging of groundwater.

4. The Practice:

The College has been steadily working towards creating and maintaining an eco-friendly and clean campus. Cutting trees on campus is strictly forbidden. We plant many new trees each year. The campus is single-use plastic free. Steel and glass tableware is used in the canteen. Environment-friendly, energy-saving LED lights that reduce wasteful disorganisations have been installed. The electrical wiring is protected against leak and short circuit through MCBs on all floors. The college uses solar street lights and practices rainwater harvesting. Waste water coming out of the Reverse Osmosis (RO) system is reused by channelizing it to water the lawns, plants and trees. Green Campus Initiatives Green initiatives in college are student ambitious. The Green Society has organized uncountable events to raise awareness on environmental issues. Organic compost is used for trees and plants on the campus. There are many trees with herbal and medicinal properties in the college ground.



INSTITUTIONAL INITIATIVES

1. RESTRICTED ENTRY OF AUTOMOBILES:

The institute encourages the staff and students to use the college transport instead of their own vehicles for safety, security, fuel conservation and to reduce environmental pollution. The college buses are checked for pollution by the authorized agency. The vehicles owned by faculty or students with pollution check stickers are permitted into the campus. For two-wheelers or four-wheelers, security measures are mandatory.

2. PEDESTRIAN-FRIENDLY PATHWAYS:

Vehicle parking space is provided on the college campus only. As the campus is vehicle free with some exceptions, students and staff experience comfort walking through the pedestrianfriendly pathways. The internal roads are lined with trees and solar lights and they are properly maintained by the campus maintenance committee.

3. BAN OF USE OF PLASTIC:

Single-use of plastic items such as plastic bottles, bags, spoons, straws and cups are banned completely and awareness is created among staff and students through orientation and display boards in the premises. To restrict the use of plastic, measures have been taken to replace plastic tea cups and glasses with steel glasses in the canteen. The staff and students are informed to use steel or copper water bottles instead of plastic bottles.

4. LANDSCAPING WITH TRESS AND PLANTS:

Landscaping of the college is worth seeing and reflects aesthetic sense. The institute has a canopy of trees and plants to make the environmental pollution free to safeguard the health of all the inmates. The lawns and the trees provide shade and beautiful ambience. Utmost care is taken to develop and maintain green landscaping by trained gardeners and supervisor. 


Ban of use of Plastic:








Pedestrian friendly pathways:
