

#### 2.7.1 Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS): 2019-20 Result Analysis -

53% of 202 students who participated in the survey responded 'good' to 'excellent' to the question on 'Relevance of the course content to the student's needs', 77% of the students expressed that 'The overall quality teaching learning process in your institution' as 'good' to 'excellent' and the remaining 23% of them expressed their dissatisfaction.

There was a positive response of 81% to the question on the 'Usage of Technical aids such as LCD, Laptop, Computer' while 19% expressed that average use of ICT and 4% their dissatisfaction. 76% of students opted that Teaching and Mentoring activity in institution facilitates youin cognitive, social and emotional growth as excellent and very good. 89% expressed that very good for the syllabus covered in class. 85% appreciated that the teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications, while the remaining 15% of them expressed that it was average and fair. 85% of students opined that the teachers motivated them for 'efforts made by teachers in promotion of skill development for jobs and life'.

84% of the students who participated in the survey opined that the 'Teachers approach to teaching' are very good, 89% of the students stated that the 'How well did teachers able to communicate' were 'excellent' and 'very good'. 78% of the students opined that 'Mentor does necessary follow up with an assigned task' were good to excellent whereas the remaining 22% of them noted that they were average and fair. 76% of the students appreciated the 'Performance in assignments discussed with students' while the remaining 24% of them expressed that it was average and fair. And for the parameter no.21, students given suggestions about placements.

# 2.7.1 Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS): 2019-220: Action taken report

- 1. As a result of the covid-19 pandemic most of the classes are covered in online and the remaining are covered through offline medium.
- Students are provided with regular classroom interactions and additionally, seminars, practical classes and industrial visits are provided.
- 3. Each semester, two internals are conducted and evaluated. Students have access to answer scripts.
- 4. Class mentors are given with the responsibility of monitoring students and making suggestions to help them improve.
- 5. Students have access to the internet, electronic journals, and the N-List, among other resources.
- 6. The college hosts guest lectures, industrial visits, and seminars.

- The college itself has various committees and cells. Students will receive training to assist them in participating in extracurricular activities.
