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
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REPORT ON PUBLIC SPEAKING

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




In the modern era of globalization, it has become a challenge to keep the customers as well as consumers in fold and even keep our natural environment safe and that is the biggest need of the time.






Discussion about topic with students







Image 6: Dr Velu Murugan Palaniappa the key note speaker of the first session






A total number of 250 delegates participated. Among the participants 170 were students and 80 were teachers.

One day national seminar came to an end with a brief valedictory function. Asst Prof. Shashi Kumar, Department of MBA delivered the valedictory notes.




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


