

#### World AIDS Day - December-2022


The concerned and socially responsible youth of the NSS unit gathered on the 1<sup>st</sup> of December 2022 to create an impact through their AIDS Awareness Program.






## **Report on Black Day**

The debate emphasized the importance of face-to-face interactions in traditional classrooms, underscoring the challenge of building interpersonal skills in a virtual environment.



#### Report on Independence Day


Don Bosco Institute of Management Studies and Computer Applications celebrated Independence Day on 15<sup>th</sup> August, 2019 at 9 am in college premises.






MEHANDI: 13.08.2018




HAIR DRESSING: 13.08.2018








TATTOOS: 13.08.2018

SOLO DANCE: 14.08.2018





MAD-ADS: 18.08.2018






